Sunday, October 4th, is **Rally Day** at Central. Activities actually start Saturday with distribution of communion elements for Sunday worship. Scott Osborne will be in the church parking lot from 10 to 11 a.m. this Saturday to distribute prepackaged communion elements for those who wish to use them. The sealed packages include a wafer and a small cup of grape juice. We do not require members to use these prepackaged elements, but we are interested in trying them to see whether we should use them if needed in the future.

Sunday's activities include our regular <u>virtual</u> worship at 10 am, including a blessing of the animals and the Lord's Supper. At 3 pm we will also have a brief service of worship on the church front lawn when we will introduce the 2020 Confirmation Class. And after this afternoon service of worship the Youth Group will stay to meet for an hour outside.

Throughout the day safety protocols will be carefully observed. We ask anyone who is sick or has encountered someone with COVID-19 to stay home. No bathrooms will be available for this brief activity.



# Treasurer's Report

For the month of August 2020, Central Church collected \$29,034 in revenue (including transfers from investment funds and interest income of \$9,895) and paid \$37,266 in expenses. Therefore, the church received \$8,232 less in revenue than it paid out in expenses. The money in the checking account decreased to \$25,766 from \$43,503 at the end of July 2020 due in part to payments made to vendors to fix the issues from flood damage sustained in the basement area (\$7,785) and also the quarterly building insurance payment (\$6,066). Pledge income is below budget for projected August by \$10,400. The revenue from projected Church Use/Rentals has come in line with budget as Park Street Academy paid in full for August. August 2020 expenses are about \$6,000 less than the amount budgeted for the period.

Please note, the investment account balances grew substantially but at this time reflect month-end July 2020.
